2010-11 APPLICANTS AND PROGRAMS

Wisconsin Higher Education Grant – UW WHEG - UW has committed 129.78% (\$75,719,863) of its appropriation with 35,169 awards. This is 6,073 more awards and 4.73% increase committed than at this time last year. In 2009-10 the program had committed 125.63% of its appropriation at this time. (W codes were applied 7/28/10 and Z codes applied 9/15/10 for the 1011 academic year. W/Z codes were applied 7/2/09 for the 0910 academic year.)

Wisconsin Higher Education Grant – WTC

WHEG – WTC has committed 164.15% (\$32,865,512) of its appropriation with 30,128 awards. This is 3,640 more awards and 8.53% increase committed than at this time last year. In 2009-10 the program had committed 155.62% of its appropriation at this time. (W codes were applied 5/6/10 and Z codes applied 8/3/10 for the 0910 academic year. W/Z codes were applied 6/4/09 for the 0910 academic year.)

Wisconsin Tuition Grant

WTG has committed 152.07% (\$41,512,381) of its appropriation with 14,988 awards. This is 2289 more awards and 17.64% more committed than at this time last year. In 2009-10 the program had committed 134.43% of its appropriation at this time.

Wisconsin Higher Education Grant – Tribal

WHEG – Tribal has committed 151.57% (\$722,001) of its appropriation with 474 awards. This is 133 less awards and 23.17% more committed than at this time last year. In 2009-10 the program had committed 128.40% of its appropriation at this time.

Status of Applicants

The number of applicants (first-time FAFSA filers who listed Wisconsin as their state of legal residence) for 2010-11, through February 15, 2011, is 356,458. Last year at this time there were 332,448 applicants. Applicants for 2009-10 totaled 345,025.
